### Policies and Processes in relation to slavery and human trafficking

- We have introduced a modern slavery policy as part of our Staff Handbook which outlines what behaviour is expected of our employees in respect of modern slavery.
- Our whistleblowing policy encourages our employees, customers, business partners and suppliers, to report any concerns, including any circumstances that may give rise to an enhanced risk of slavery or human trafficking.

### Due diligence processes for modern slavery and human trafficking

- We strictly prohibit the use of modern slavery and human trafficking in our business operations and supply chain.
- All suppliers of SSL247 Ltd. are subject to an internal assessment as per ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 27001:2017 standards. We hold the responsibility to ensure that its suppliers and partners are compliant with Modern Slavery Act 2015 and verify whether they have their modern slavery and human trafficking policies and procedures in place.
- We expect our employees to uphold the company commitment towards Modern Slavery Act 2015 and engage with stakeholders and suppliers to address the risk of modern slavery where this could be a concern.

### Our effectiveness in combating modern slavery and human trafficking

- We strive to maintain the highest standards of conduct and ethical behaviour from our employees and our suppliers.
- To identify and mitigate the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking we have introduced systems to encourage reporting of concerns and the protection of whistle-blowers.
- We maintain a level of communication and personal contact with the next link in our supply chain to ensure their understanding of, and compliance with, our expectations and compliance.
- We are committed to continually evaluate modern slavery and human trafficking risks which are monitored by our procurement and compliance teams.

### Training
